1. RULES

1.1. The Rules specify the principles of sectoral classification of Companies.

2. SECTOR CLASSIFICATION PRINCIPLES

- 2.1. The Administrator classifies Companies into one of the sectors depending on their business profile and receivers of their services.
- 2.2. When defining a business profile of the Company, the Administrator shall consider in particular the following:
 - a) structure of revenue according to annual reports,
 - b) structure of assets,
 - c) PKD code (Polish Classification of Activities).
- 2.3. In case of any doubt, the Administrator may request an opinion of the Oversight Committee or the Exchange.
- 2.4. The list of sectors referred to in 2.1 is defined in Appendix 1 hereto.
- 2.5. On the basis of the list of sectors referred to 2.4, the Administrator drafts and updates sectoral lists of Companies.
- 2.6. Companies shall be entered into a sector list of companies prior to the first trading day of the company's financial instruments on the exchange or in the alternative trading system, respectively, subject to 2.7.
- 2.7. In case of business profile change of a Company or a change of receivers of its services the sectoral list of Companies may by updated accordingly.
- 2.8. Sector classification of a company may be modified at the request of the company or as part of the annual review of the sector classification of companies performed by the Administrator.
- 2.9. To request the Administrator to change its sector classification, a Company shall use the form presented in Appendix 2.
- 2.10. Modifications referred to in 2.7 and 2.8 shall take effect no earlier than one week after their publication.

3. FINAL PROVISIONS

3.1. These Rules enter into force on January 1st, 2020.
